Showcase 2012 RECITAL RULES FOR DANCERS

Dear Dance Parents:

Please understand these policies:

1. Any dancer may participate as long as they are full-time, registered students in good standing. You must sign up for the recital and order a costume, (see other side).
2. Your child must attend all his/her regular classes September through June in order to participate in this show. Excessive missed classes or rehearsals may result in a dancer being disqualified for this show.
3. Your dancer must attend all scheduled rehearsals, and any extra rehearsals that might be needed.
4. If you miss classes or rehearsals, your child will not be ready for this show and will have to be dropped from the show.
5. This is voluntary. Please do not sign up if you will have any problems attending classes or rehearsals. If your family does sports, church or other activities, this may conflict with the studio requirements for attendance.
6. Tickets will most likely be sold at the studio for general admission. Usual prices are \$18-20 adult, \$10-15 kids/seniors
7. Again, costumes must be paid for in CASH only. There are NO REFUNDS for any reason.
8. If you drop out, move away or quit for any reason or if your dancer is disqualified due to excessive absences or non-attendance of rehearsals, there is no refund.

Extra requirements: A recital fee of \$35.00 per student will help pay the costs of using the Sherwood Hall stage, auditorium, stage lighting, security, etc. The costs have gone up and it looks like expenses will be more than double what we have paid over the past 30 years.

**There are two shows. Dancers in more than one dance may be performing in one or both shows. A ballet & tap student may perform ballet in one show, tap in the other. Separate tickets are needed for each of the two shows. Please take this into consideration when ordering costumes. You may need tickets to two different shows.

You may be asked to purchase special tights or other necessities for your dancer. All dancers should have clean, new tights and nice shoes without holes, stains, etc. There may be a requirement for a hair style, such as a classical bun for ballet students. No jewelry or make up is allowed.
